  Like dawn spreading across the mountains a large and mighty army comes, such as never was in ancient times nor ever will be in ages to come.
- Before them fire devours, behind them a flame blazes. Before them the land is like the garden of Eden, behind them, a desert

- waste— nothing escapes them.
