Luke 24:1-12 (NIV)

- 24:1 On the first day of the week, very early in the morning, the women took the spices they had prepared and went to the tomb.
- 2 They found the stone rolled away from the tomb,
- 3 but when they entered, they did not find the body of the Lord Jesus.
- While they were wondering about this, suddenly two men in clothes that gleamed like lightning stood beside them.
- In their fright the women bowed down with their faces to the ground, but the men said to them, "Why do you look for the living among the dead?
- He is not here; he has risen! Remember how he told you, while he was still with you in Galilee:
- 7 'The Son of Man must be delivered over to the hands of sinners, be crucified and on the third day be raised again.'

- It was Mary Magdalene, Joanna, Mary the mother of James, and the others with them who told this to the apostles.
