Matthew 7:1-12 (NIV)

- 7:1 "Do not judge, or you too will be judged.
- For in the same way you judge others, you will be judged, and with the measure you use, it will be measured to you.
- 3 "Why do you look at the speck of sawdust in your brother's eye and pay no attention to the plank in your own eye?
- How can you say to your brother, 'Let me take the speck out of your eye,' when all the time there is a plank in your own eye?
- You hypocrite, first take the plank out of your own eye, and then you will see clearly to remove the speck from your brother's eye.
- 6 "Do not give dogs what is sacred; do not throw your pearls to pigs. If you do, they may trample them under their feet, and turn and tear you to pieces.
- 7 "Ask and it will be given to you; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you.
- For everyone who asks receives; the one who seeks finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened.
- 9 "Which of you, if your son asks for bread, will give him a stone?
